Baird Middle School Gold and Silver Students came to the Club for a glow stick dance party for achieving good grades and good attendance.



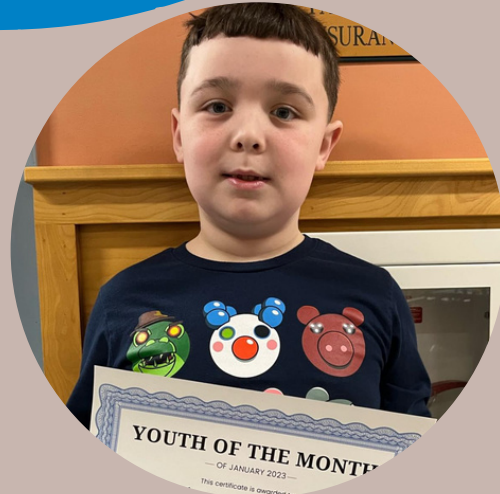
