First Year Group Project

As a group (there are two groups per school) you will develop a mission and vision for your group project. This group project can be done with a local non-profit, assisted living group, Johns Creek Senior Center, City of Johns Creek, Autrey Mill Nature Center, Drake House, North Fulton Community Charities, etc., your school, or through an elementary or middle school mentoring leadership skills to your younger counterparts. Update to Mrs. Sanders due by SEPTEMBER 30, including the following:

- Group Team Name
- Mission and Vision of project
- Administration between your group and the organization you will be working with (school sponsor included, asked for advice and consent.)
- Project timeline complete

Group School Project Management Checklist – due by **OCTOBER 30**:

- Project selection process identified and complete
- Necessary permission forms completed accordingly
- Meeting dates and times established
- Team duties clearly outlined
- Vision for end product

Presentation should follow the following criteria, one per group, due by MARCH 1:

- Multimedia presentation that is less than 3 minutes in length
- Suitable for usage by local media outlets or for publicity
- How would you rate your overall experience doing the project?
- What was the most relevant content area/activity? Why?
- What leadership skills and experiences did you witness or experience during this project?
- What would you keep the same, do differently?
- Tell us something else about your group experience

Intergeneration Mentoring – this will be an optional group project with AT&T in 2019, this project can be including in your end of year video, if you want.
