DATES	DESTINATION	DESCRIPTION
Week 1: July 6-10	The Caribbean	Every island in the Caribbean has its own special flavor, with diverse landscapes and wildlife, intriguing rhythms, and beautiful artwork. This week we will adventure with the Taino people, salsa through the streets of Santiago de Cuba, merengue across the beautiful island of Hispaniola, and let the drums take the lead as we dance the bomba in Puerto Rico.
Week 2: July 13-17	Spain	Come and fall in love with Spain! Students will explore the diversity of Spain's culture in a journey through the various

		regions of the country and discover dance forms including folklore, danza estilizada, and flamenco. Uncover interesting facts about Spain's geography, history, food and famous citizens while we learn about its culture, art, and festivals. Explorers will be mesmerized as they step into the world of Spanish Dance, moving to the beautiful sounds of the guitar, the rhythmic quality of the palmas & zapateado, and working with the Spanish fan, all led by special guest artists!
Week 3: July 20-24	Venezuela	Discover the wonders of Venezuela, from the magnificent waterfalls tumbling off tabletop mountains to the Orinoco Delta teeming with wildlife. Campers will explore the Catatumbo lightning phenomenon, Los Llanos with countless capybara and crocodiles, and the National Pantheon in Caracas. They will dance to the beat of the Joropo as they delve into the art, music and dances that shape everyday life in Venezuela.

Monday, July 6 - Friday July 10, 2020**

TIME	CLASS DESCRIPTION <i>*Open studio observations on Friday, July 10, 2020 for parents and guardians only.</i>
9:30-10:30	Sevillanas: Students will learn various coplas of the Spanish folk dance, Sevillanas, including its history and festive tradition of Feria de Sevilla.
10:30-10:40	Break
10:40-11:40	Flamenco Footwork & Castanets: Spanish Dance forms have been the backbone of the Ballet Hispánico School of Dance since its founding in the early 1970s. This class will give students the opportunity to focus on strengthening the execution and precision of their footwork and castanet technique for Spanish Dance.
11:40-12:30	Lunch
12:30-2:00	Ballet: Students are introduced to a ballet curriculum that enables them to develop a holistic understanding and mastery of technical skills in a disciplined yet nurturing environment. Our ballet program emphasizes clarity of line, execution and precision, dynamic movement, musicality, and artistic expression. Our curriculum draws from the internationally renowned Cuban methodology, which emphasizes plasticity and virtuosity to create proficient and powerful dancers.
2:00-2:10	Break
2:10-3:10	Pre-Pointe/Pointe: Students will develop their pointe technique through strengthening and conditioning exercises specifically for pointe work. The class can be taken in both flat ballet shoes and pointe shoes, and will focus on developing the students' knowledge and execution of pre-pointe/pointe fundamentals.

3:10-3:20	Break
3:20-4:20	Modern: Classes focus on developing core dance principles, such as balance and coordination, while exploring diverse movement concepts. The curriculum includes spinal articulation, floorwork, movement dynamics, use of weight, and complex rhythms, creating students adaptable to the contemporary dance landscape.

4:30-5:30	Stretch & Conditioning: Dancers will be guided through stretching and conditioning exercises that support a dancer's flexibility, strength, and overall fitness.
