

A how-to guide for city residents to prepare **Yard Waste for Curbside Collection** this fall

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- The 2024 fall curbside collection is scheduled for **three Thursdays in October** (October 10, 17, and 24).
- Yard waste must **be curbside by 6am** on collection days.
- **Maximum of 4** bags or bundles per week; can be a combination of bags and bundles **NOT to exceed 4 in total**.
(example: 2 bags + 2 bundles = 4 total OR 3 bags + 1 bundle = 4 total)
- Each recyclable paper bag should **NOT exceed 35 pounds**.

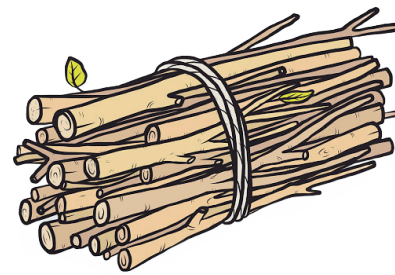


CLIPPINGS / LEAVES

Place yard waste such as grass clippings, leaves, and small twigs in recyclable paper bags. Bags will **NOT** be picked up if they are plastic, wet, and/or torn. **DO NOT exceed 35 pounds in weight.**



NO furniture, appliances, dirt, rocks, sod, and/or construction debris will be picked up.



BRANCHES / LIMBS

Ensure branches and limbs are less than 4 feet in length, bundled, and tied with biodegradable twine. **DO NOT exceed 4 feet in length.**
