OSBnb is a student-run bed and breakfast whose features exceed ADA requirements, located in housing on the OSB campus. OSBnb increases accessible accommodations for individuals with disabilities, and provides job training and work experience for students, demonstrating their abilities in the workplace.

Outcomes – Impact

Short to Mid-term

- Students gain work readiness skills and are paid
- Students experience increased personal esteem and motivation
- Accessibility for individuals with disabilities
- Replicable, adaptable curriculum
- Visually impaired individuals demonstrate their abilities at work, changing perceptions

Long-term

- Students translate work experience into gainful employment
- Increased accessible accommodations for individuals with disabilities
- Enhanced awareness of people with visual impairments and their abilities
- Increased employment opportunities for the visually impaired
