The Johnson County Recycling District and Shares, Inc. will host a document shredding and electronics collection event on Saturday, August 19th from 9:00 a.m. to noon at the District office located at: 900 Arvin Rd., Suite A in Franklin. The event is FREE and open to Johnson County residents and businesses. Documents will be collected in locked containers and shredded off-site at Shares, Inc. in Shelbyville, IN. If bringing large quantities, please have items to be shredded in a container that can be left behind (boxes preferred). Electronic recycling will also be available on this day, however **NO TV'S/MONITORS or GENERAL RECYLING will be accepted.**

The Johnson County Tox Box will be open for residential use Saturday, August 19th from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. **by appointment only**. Please visit our website, [JCRD.org](http://jcrd.org) to set up your appointment time. The Tox Box is located at 1051 Hospital Road, Franklin. The following items are accepted FREE of charge at the Tox Box: household cleaning supplies, yard and pool chemicals, automotive fluids, poisons, aerosol cans, adhesives, oil-based paint and stain. **No latex paint, batteries, or light bulbs will be accepted! Open for Johnson County residents only. No businesses, contractors or small quantity generators will be accepted.**
