The Scholarship Committee of the Martin Luther King, Jr. CommUNITY of Greater Kennett Area is pleased to announce the awarding of two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 to honor the life and legacy of the late Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to two (2) graduating seniors from the following High Schools - Avon Grove, Kennett, and Unionville.

Our goal is to assist scholarship recipients with expenses while attending their first year at a postsecondary institution. The application is available online at www.mlkcommunity.org.

The Scholarship Committee will review all application information and rank applications based on the following criteria:

Scholarship Requirements:

- 1) High School graduate and acceptance to an accredited college or university.
- 2) Cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 or greater.
- 3) Demonstrated commitment to principles of peace and harmony among all people.
- 4) Completion of a 500 to 600 word essay based on the topic below:

The theme of this year's Martin Luther King Birthday Celebration is, "The Fierce Urgency of Now." Please discuss the injustice(s) in the nation that you believe require fierce urgency and what should be done.

The **deadline** to submit the application and essay is **April 15, 2022**.

Note: Awarding of the scholarships is in the sole discretion of the scholarship committee. Scholarship applications must meet all criteria to receive the award. The awards are non-transferable and will be awarded at the student's graduation and/or awards program.
