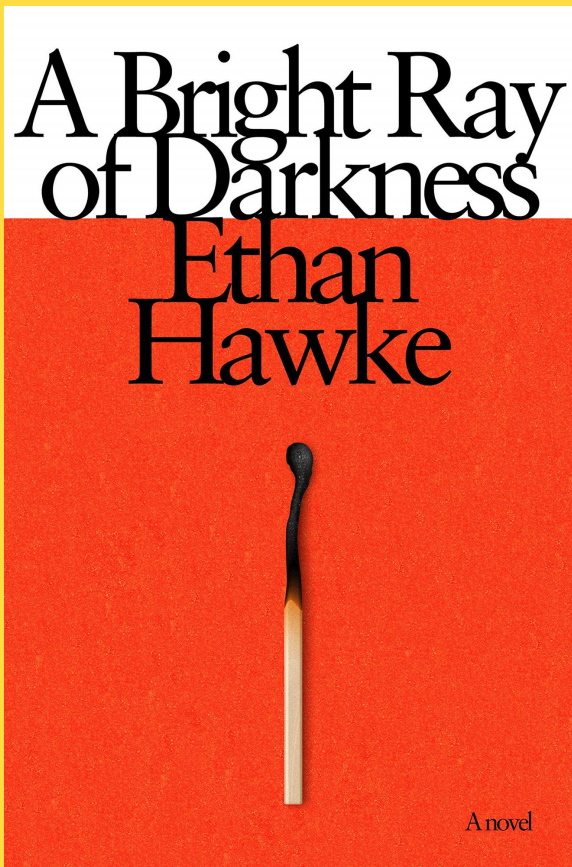

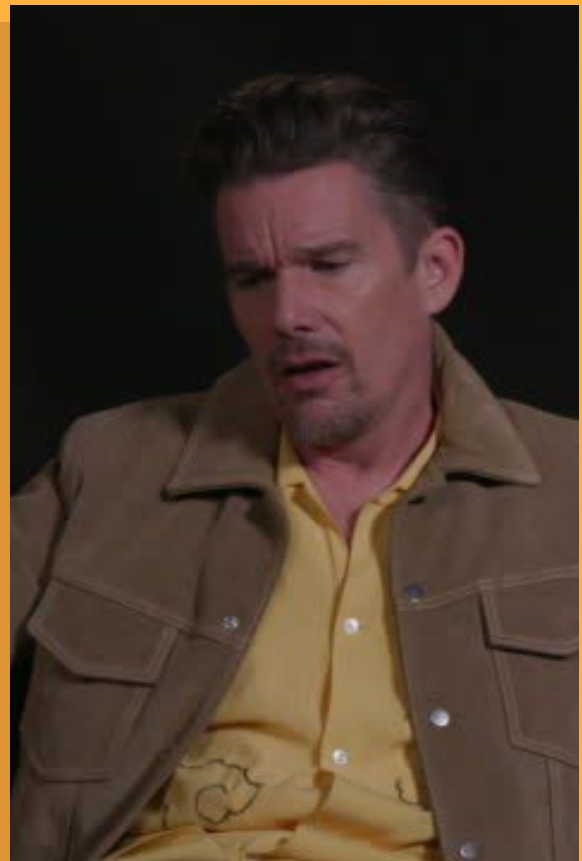
NEW BOOK BY ETHAN HAWKE
