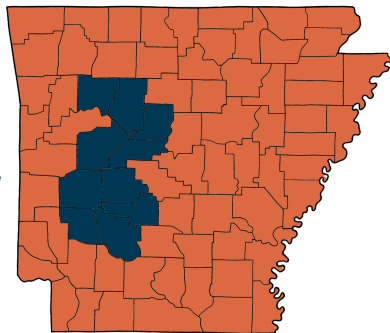

WIOA QUALIFICATIONS QUESTIONNAIRE



DISLOCATED WORKER PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to receive WIOA services in the dislocated worker program, an individual must:

- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Be registered for Selective Service or have valid exemption.
- Be able to work in the United States.
- Provide a valid Social Security Number.
- Must meet criteria of one of the following categories...

CATEGORY A- INDIVIDUAL

LAYOFF. The applicant must meet **ALL** three of the conditions below:

- Affected by termination, layoff, or notice of termination.
- Meets unemployment compensation criteria: Worked enough but not eligible due to low earnings or non-covered employment.
- Unlikely to return to prior industry/occupation per Arkansas state policy (TEGL 19-16 compliant).

CATEGORY B- BUSINESS CLOSURE OR SUBSTANTIAL LAYOFF.

The applicant must meet **ONE** of the conditions below:

- Has been terminated or laid off or has received a notice of termination or layoff from employment as a result of any permanent closure or any substantial layoff at a plant, facility, or enterprise.
- Is employed at a facility at which the employer has made a general announcement that such facility will close within 180 days.

IN ADDITION TO THE DEFINITION OF "SUBSTANTIAL LAYOFF",

Arkansas state policy clarifies that being laid off as a result of any substantial layoff must meet **ONE** of the following conditions:

- Permanently laid off from employment.
- Laid off for an indefinite period, with no expected return date.
- Temporarily laid off, with a scheduled call-back date at least 30 days from the layoff date.

CATEGORY C- SELF-EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS.

An individual who was previously self-employed (including employment as a farmer, a rancher, or a fisherman) but is unemployed as a result of general economic conditions in the community in which the individual resides or because of natural disasters qualifies as a dislocated worker.

CATEGORY D- DISPLACED

HOMEMAKER. The applicant must meet **ALL** three of the conditions below:

- Dependent on income, but no longer supported.
- Dependent spouse of active-duty Armed Forces member; income by deployed, duty change, disability, or death.
- Unemployed/underemployed, struggling to find/upgrade employment.

CATEGORY E- SPOUSE OF AN ACTIVE-DUTY MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES.

The applicant must meet **ONE** of the following conditions:

- Lost job due to member's station relocation.
- Unemployed or underemployed, struggling to find/upgrade work.
