Register for a temporary library card (length of time valid no longer listed on MCPL site) for Montgomery County Libraries. You are eligible if you live, work, or go to school in Montgomery County; or live in MD, D.C., Alexandria, Arlington, Falls Church, Fairfax, Loudoun, or Prince William Counties in VA.

Register for a virtual card. This card is good for 3 years for Prince George's County residents and 6 months for residents of MD, D.C., Alexandria, Arlington, Fairfax, Falls Church, Loudoun, and Prince William Counties in VA.

Out of State residents may be charged a one-time fee of \$40.

Register for a temporary (90 day) library card, does not have access to all digital content (You are eligible for a library card if you live in D.C., Montgomery or Prince George's County in MD, in Alexandria, Arlington, Falls Church, Fairfax, Loudoun, Prince William, or Frederick Counties in VA.)

You are eligible for a free library card if you live or own property in Fairfax County, the City of Fairfax, or the towns of Herndon or Vienna. Reciprocal jurisdictions include D.C., Frederick, Montgomery, and Prince Georges County in MD, Alexandria, Falls Church, Manassas, Manassas Park, Arlington, Fauquier, Loudoun, and Prince William Counties in VA.

This card will provided you with access to most of Arlington's digital resources. You are eligible for a free library card if live in Arlington, Alexandria, Fairfax County, Falls Church, Fauquier, Loudoun, and Prince William Counties in VA, D.C., and Frederick, Montgomery, and Prince Georges County in MD.
