Getting Started with your Digital Library



To access e-books, audiobooks, or magazines on a computer:

Visit cheboyganlibrary.org

Click on "Digital Catalog"

Tap the "sign in" button on the right side of the screen.

Select the Cheboygan Area Public Library from the drop down menu.

Enter your library card number and click "sign in".

Enjoy browsing! Find an audiobook, e-book, or magazine that you wish to borrow. Click on "borrow" and follow the prompts.

To use this collection on a tablet, phone, kindle, or other hand-held device, download the Libby app!
