**Orange County**

***Orlando International Airport***

**Eastbound and westbound Cargo Rd. between Bear Rd. and Casa Verde Rd. (north of Orlando International Airport)**

Extended single lane closure in each direction through 2020 for bridge work. One lane will remain open in each direction.

**Eastbound and westbound Cargo Rd. between Casa Verde Rd. and Heintzelman Blvd.**

**Northbound I-95 exit ramp to Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 205)**

Full ramp closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday night, August 16, through Monday morning, August 17. *Closure is necessary for milling and resurfacing of existing SR-528 and setting of barrier wall.*
