How do the many stories in the Five Books of Moses relate to each other? What do they tell us about the mission of the Jewish people? Is there a narrative thread that connects the Five Books together? In this class we will start from the book of Genesis (*Beresheit*) and finish at the book of Deuteronomy (*Devarim*). We will show how major events through the Chumash connect together and in the process better understand the unique themes of each book. The class relies heavily on the teaching of Rav Menachem Leibtag (www.tanach.org).

Please bring a Hebrew-English Chumash with you to this session.

Jennifer Raskas is the Vice President of Torah Learning at Kemp Mill Synagogue, Silver Spring, MD. She has taught Jewish classes in synagogues, schools and summer programs around the country and in Israel. She is the author of *The Book of Ruth, A Contrast to the End of the Book of Judges*, which appeared in Volume 43:4 of the *Jewish Bible Quarterly*. Jennifer is also the Director of the Israel Action Center of the Jewish Community Relations Council (JCRC) of Greater Washington and has 10 years of professional experience working directly for, or on behalf of the State of Israel. She received her Bachelor of Arts from Columbia University and her Master's Degree in Public Policy from the Harvard Kennedy School of Government.
