WHAT: NEW opportunity to earn Professional Development Hours (PDH) while providing a valuable service to surveyors around the state

WHO: This opportunity is available to:

- Licensed professionals in need of professional development hours
- Those in need of additional office experience, conducting research, to qualify for examination
- Passionate surveyors at any level who have time to volunteer

TRAINING OPTIONS:

1) A two-hour research class

This course will provide:

- How to research records using WebXtender, including tips and “tricks” for maximizing its functionality to find specific records, or record types
- The history and origin of donated records
- A full explanation of where donated records are stored

2) Between two (2) to (8) eight-hour hands-on records review

- The PLSO will provide hands-on experience in evaluating and indexing records
- The skill and knowledge level of each participant will determine the level of supervision and/or mentorship provided by the PLSO staff.

WHERE:

- The two-hour research class will be available in person at the DNR Tumwater compound or through a webinar format for those outside of the area.
- Hands-on records review will be conducted at our Tumwater facility, or other locations around the State, as available, under the supervision of PLSO staff.

WHEN:

- This will be an on-going training program with no set date. The date and time will be coordinated between those interested individuals and the PLSO. The PLSO will make every reasonable effort to meet the student’s schedule.

PDH CREDIT:

- The PLSO will provide a certificate of participation for each attendee’s records.
- This program has been reviewed by the Washington Board of Registration. PDH Credit is accepted at the Board’s sole discretion.
