Important Dates:

- Voter registration- must be completed [online https://registertovote.ca.gov/](https://registertovote.ca.gov/) or postmark by **October 24, 2022** or you can conditionally register and vote at your county elections office after the 15-day voter registration deadline.
- Vote-by-mail ballot request- must arrive by **November 1, 2022**.
- Completed ballots, including vote-by-mail ballots- personally delivered ballots must be delivered by close of polls on **November 8, 2022**; Mailed ballots must be postmarked on or before **November 8, 2022**, and received by your county elections office no later than **November 15, 2022**.
- Election Date- November 8, 2022 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. VOTE AT ANY POLLING PLACE! <https://www.lavote.gov/home/voting-elections/voting-options/voting-in-person/about>

Nonpartisan Voter Information for the November 8, 2022 Election

The California general election is three weeks away on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 and every registered voter in the state will receive a mail-in ballot due to election law changes as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Voters must decide on 7 statewide ballot measures this year, along with local ballot measures unique to each city and county. **California Choices**— www.californiachoices.org updated for the 2022 election—is a **nonpartisan** one-stop shop for ballot measure information, including **endorsements**, <https://www.californiachoices.org/ballot-endorsements-2022-11> pro and con arguments, in depth analysis, polling, and additional statewide and local **voter resources**. <https://www.californiachoices.org/voter-resources>

For the second election year, California Choices has been expanded to include local ballot measure information and endorsements for seven of the most populous counties in the state— Los Angeles is included. <https://www.californiachoices.org/los-angeles-ballot-measures-2022-11> Each county has its own unique endorsements table with the ability to save and email your votes to yourself to make it easier to fill out your ballot— whether in person or by mail.
