- 5. Participants and their parents should attend a mandatory team meeting on **Sunday, February 26.** Students will be expected to participate in meetings on Sundays **March 26**, **April 30**, and **June 4**. Please mark your calendars now and notify Chelsea with any conflicts ASAP.

Risk Statement:

While the missions committee of FCCH, in partnership with its partner organizations, will take measures to minimize safety and health risks for trip participants, certain unforeseen incidents can arise and we cannot guarantee safety. Traveling to and working in many countries, and even many US cities, carries inherent risks. These include criminal acts, weather emergencies and health crises. If any of these events should occur, there would also be emotional consequences.

While the missions committee will conduct a risk assessment for each sponsored trip, all participants are encouraged to do their own research and risk review especially with respect to any personal health or other challenges.

All participants are responsible to receive recommended immunizations and vaccinations. Any personal health issues should be disclosed to trip leaders so potential medical treatments can be considered and planned.
