Trailways pays tribute to J.H. Byrd, Jr. - Salter Trailways



Trailways Transportation System remembers J.H. Byrd, Jr., President of Salter Trailways, who passed away on August 1, 2022, at the age of 69.

A third-generation family member to run the 100-year-old bus business based in Jonesboro, Louisiana, Byrd began working full-time for Salter Trailways in 1971, eventually taking over ownership and operations.

He is remembered for his devotion to his family, business, and community. A supporter of his Jonesboro-Hodge high school, Byrd arranged for the school's teams and fans to travel to away games in comfortable coaches for over 30 years and often times did the driving so he could be there to support the teams, according to his obituary.

A long-time member of Trailways, the company originally provided daily, intercity, fixed-route line run services and later shifted to charter bus service, serving schools, church groups, active military, and veterans, along with other social and local groups.

"J.H. lived a wonderful life and will be missed by all who he loved and cherished in this world," his family said. Jonesboro's Paradise Funeral Homes has posted a tribute to J.H. on its Facebook page.

Are your brake systems in compliance?

While Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance's (CVSA's) annual Brake Safety Week held in August has passed, implementing regularly scheduled preventative maintenance is key to maintaining a safe and compliant brake system.

According to an expert motorcoach technician, brake inspections quickly reveal if something is wrong. With brakes, it isn't about the mileage. If running coaches hard, operators are advised to put the coach in the service bay and inspect brakes once a month. Otherwise, always follow the intervals noted in the model's maintenance manual.

Brake-related violations comprise the largest percentage of all out-of-service vehicle violations cited during roadside inspections, according to CVSA's **2021 International Roadcheck data**. Brake systems and brake adjustment violations accounted for the highest percentage of all vehicle out-of-service violations.
