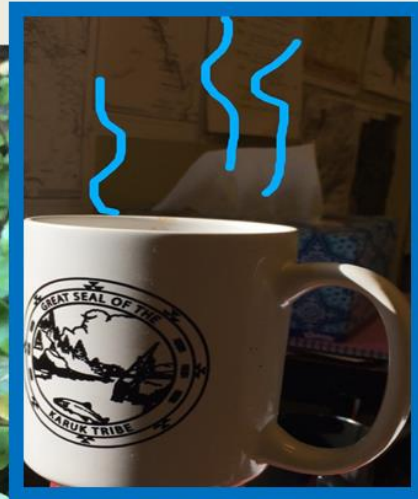


2017 Winter Food Security Youth Camp
