We are at the beginning of an exciting new chapter for Clifton Springs Hospital & Clinic. We hope you choose to be a part of it.



# The Medical Village

Working within our current footprint, we have initiated a \$32 million renovation that will create an outpatient center of more than 50,000 square feet that enables us to focus on community wellness, by adding new programs and expanding existing ones.

Not only does this modernize physical spaces that are nearly 50 years old, it also helps us provide residents of Ontario County with greater access to primary care and specialty service providers. Construction is scheduled to be completed by January 2020.
