Cook-Off Contact Congregation

- Recruit cooks to register
- Publicize event through announcement, bulletins, newsletter
- Have fun publicizing and selling the event!
- Set up tables on the perimeter of the room for the chefs (any decorating is up to you)
- Have water bottles available for a \$1 – ask church members to donate them.
- Ask church members to donate baked or dessert items and have a dessert table with a *Donations Accepted* sign for the table.
- While people are eating, bands or other musical groups could be playing. It is nice if the music comes from the congregations, ex., choirs, bluegrass bands, light rock, country, etc.
- Find three judges – ideas to ask clergy, local politicians, Town/Village Office holders, police chief/sheriff
- Please, **DO NOT** ask local business for donations as it will interfere with asking for Bedrace donations

- Please, **DO NOT** ask local business for donations as it will interfere with asking for Bedrace donations

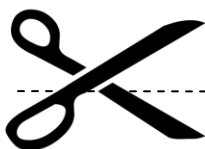
FPOC will provide
