

82nd Avenue Projects – SE Lindy Street to Mount Scott Creek Bridge

Paving and sidewalk improvements

SE 82nd Avenue is an important transportation route that serves the Clackamas Regional Center, an area heavily used by commuters and shoppers. The highway needs to be repaved and also lacks sidewalks and sidewalk ramps at several major intersections. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will improve SE 82nd Avenue between SE Lindy Street and Mount Scott Creek Bridge for all users by repaving the highway and installing sidewalk ramps at intersections to make it easier for everyone to get where they need to go.

82nd Avenue Projects

SE Lindy Street to Mount Scott Creek Bridge

Spring 2017

Recent work completed

ODOT completed the first phase of the project in summer 2015, which included repaving the southern portion of SE 82nd Avenue between SE King Road and the Mount Scott Creek Bridge. Bike lanes were installed between SE King Road and SE Sunnyside Road.

Upcoming improvements

Project phases 2 and 3 will improve sidewalk ramps at key intersections between SE Lindy Street and the Mount Scott Creek Bridge. These phases will bring the sidewalk ramps up to the current ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) standards. While there is a larger need to improve sidewalks along SE 82nd Avenue, ODOT has selected several areas to improve during phases 2 and 3 based on available funds, available space for building a wider sidewalk, and areas of high use.

Phase 3 will include repaving SE 82nd Avenue between SE Lindy Street and SE King Road. Bike lanes will be added where the road is wide enough.

What to expect

Sidewalk improvements for phase 2 are expected to start in March/April 2017 and nighttime paving could begin in June 2017. This work is expected to be completed by July 2017. Phase 3 work between SE Lindy Street and SE King Road is not expected to begin until fall 2017.

ODOT will reduce construction impacts by:

- Working on sidewalks and ADA ramps during the day. There will be single lane closures at the work zone with few impacts to motorists. Safe detour routes will be provided for pedestrians. ODOT will work with TriMet to temporarily relocate bus stops in construction areas.
- Paving at night. Only one lane will be closed at a time and intersections will be affected for the shortest amount of time needed to finish the work. Paving will take place from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Monday through Friday and from 7 p.m. to 10 a.m. on the weekends.

What is the project schedule?

Construction will take place in three phases through 2018. ODOT will update the schedule on LMSC.82ndAveProjects.com as the project progresses.

Schedule is subject to change due to weather and site conditions.
