3	(a) In General.—Under the securities laws (as such
4	term is defined in section 3(a)(47) of the Securities Ex-
5	change Act of 1934 (15 U.S.C. 78c)), an issuer shall not
6	be construed to be required to disclose or otherwise pro-
7	vide the information described in subsection (b).
8	(b) Information.—The information described in
9	this subsection is as follows:
10	(1) The greenhouse-gas emissions or consump-

12	(A) the issuer; or
13	(B) the supply chain or consumers of such
14	issuer (commonly known as "Scope 3 emis-
15	sions").
