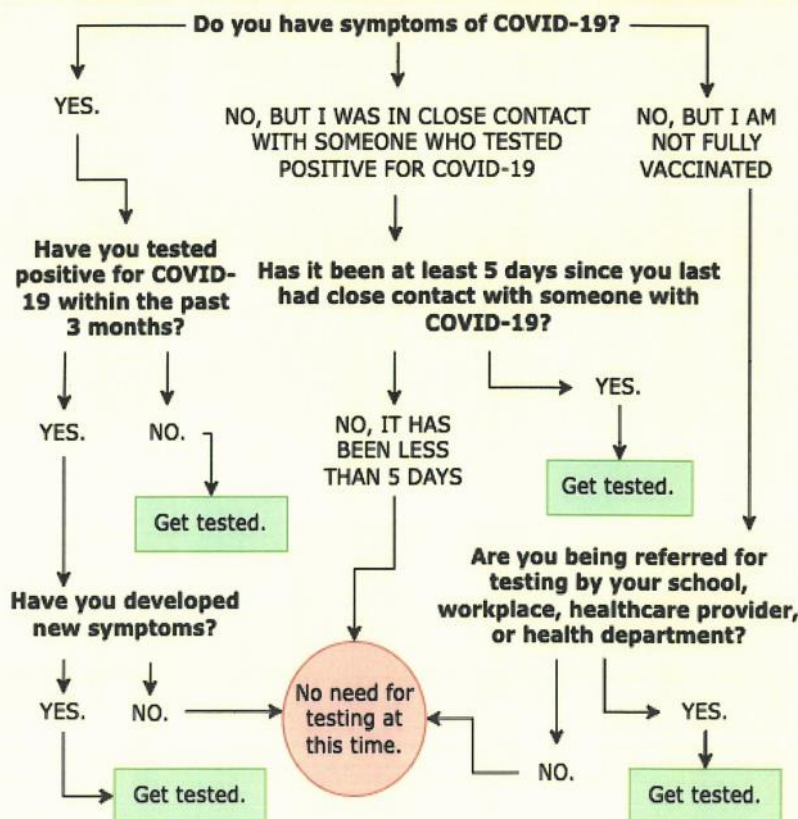

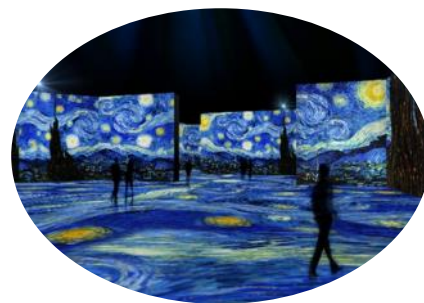

First UMC will offer the GriefShare support group on Tuesday afternoons, beginning **February 1 through April 26, from 1:30 – 3:30, Room 118**. GriefShare is a 13-week faith-based program for people who have experienced the death of a spouse, family members, or friends. Three key elements are involved:

- *a video seminar focused on key, grief-related topics which is hosted by spiritual leaders and Christian grief / trauma counselors, all of whom have experienced deep grief themselves.
- *a personal workbook for study and individual application of the weekly topics.
- *group discussion in a safe environment of people who, more than most, understand your grief.
