- » Presentation description, title and duration
- » Presentation method/audience engagement

SPEAKER SUBMISSION EVALUATION CRITERIA

Speaker submissions will be evaluated using the following criteria:

Relevance

- ✓ The topic is relevant to the Summit's theme *Embracing Inclusivity & Resilience – A Path Forward*.
- ✓ The topic is relevant to the Arts, Culture and Heritage sector.
- ✓ Attendees will be able to relate to the content and apply what they have learned.
- ✓ The presentation provides informative, educational, non-commercial content.

Creativity/Innovation

- ✓ The subject matter is innovative or presents new ideas.
- ✓ The content provides a thought-leadership perspective.
- ✓ Content is presented in a creative and engaging way.

Clarity

- ✓ The session description and title demonstrate the intent in a clear and concise way.
- ✓ The presentation message and learning outcome for attendees is clear.

Knowledge/Experience

- ✓ The presenter is knowledgeable and experienced on the topic.
- ✓ The presenter has identified how they will engage the audience throughout the session.
