Kindergarten - Grade 5: March 16- 20: Choose one full-day block of six activities for the week
Grade 6 - 9: March 16 - 20 & March 23 - 27: Choose from four half-day intensives over two weeks

General Information

Kindergarten – Grade 5 Spring Break Camp

Students from kindergarten to grade 2 and grades 3 to 5 choose one full-day block that runs Monday – Friday. Each block contains six classes of activities. Small class sizes ensure that students receive quality time with their teachers. Please refer to the timetable for the content of each block.

Students must bring a nut-free lunch and a snack each day.

Grades 6 – 9 Spring Break Intensives

Four, week-long, half-day art intensives run over the two weeks of the SD#43 Spring Break and are designed specifically for youth, allowing them to delve more fully into their chosen art form. Students taking both morning and afternoon intensives should bring a nut-free lunch and snack each day.

Registration

Registration opens on **Monday, January 20**. Registration may be done online starting at 12:01 am or by phone at 604.664.1636 or in person starting at 9:00 am, and is on a first-come, first-served basis. Full payment of program fees must be made at the time of registration.

Withdrawal

A student may withdraw up to seven (7) days prior to the camp start date. A refund of the class fee will be granted less the non-refundable registration fee. Refunds will not be granted after the seven (7) day period has passed. Exceptions for medical or compassionate reasons may be considered upon receipt of a written request submitted at least 24 hours prior to the start date of the class to info@placedesarts.ca. A medical certificate may be required. Upon approval, a refund of the class fee will be granted, less the registration fee and any applicable supply fees.

Kindergarten – Grade 5 Camp: March 16 – 20

Art About YOU

In this class, you will create mixed media art inspired by a VIP (very important person) - YOU. You will explore a variety of art techniques and styles to create one-of-a-kind artwork including a personalized stamp, a mini-zine and more, that could only be made by you.

Clay Play

Use your imagination and have fun creating unique clay projects. Individual exploration is encouraged as you discover cool techniques of clay. Projects will be finished with either paint or glaze to take home on Friday.

Dance Sampler

In this introductory all-in-one dance class, you'll explore a variety of dance styles like jazz, hip hop and breakdance. Learn the fundamentals of each dance style and have fun doing it! Wear comfortable clothing you can move in.

Digital Art: Game Design

Bring your passion for play and creative mind and become a master game designer! Learn how to build video games, create board games and design your own physical game. Think, design and create like a professional game developer. You will learn how to use Unity, the software that game developers, scientists and engineers use to create interactive games and explore new ideas. Computers will be provided for students to work.

Drums Around the World

Explore drums and rhythms from around the world. Using drums, percussion, computers and synthesizers, you will learn how to play rhythms from many cultures.

Guitar Around the World

Learn basic guitar techniques and explore musical cultures from around the world. You will listen to and have the opportunity to play a variety of music from places like Jamaica, Africa, Cuba, Spain and China. This is a fun introduction to the world of music and guitar! Guitars will be provided for the class.

Hip Hop and Breakdance

Learn the fundamentals of hip hop and breakdancing! Kick it old school with classic moves like the baby freeze, 6-step and coffee grinder, and then combine these moves into a wicked dance piece. Wear comfortable clothing you can move in.

Hip Hop Kidz

Dance to the rhythm of your favourite music and learn a dance routine that is full of flavah! Classes will include a variety of movement and coordination games and fun activities. Wear comfortable clothing you can move in.

Inspiring Artists: Acrylics, Collage and More!

Get inspired by famous artists and create your own art! After looking at the works of artists like Gustav Klimt and Frida Kahlo, you will use acrylic paints, collage, pastels and watercolors to get creative with different artistic styles.

Musical Theatre Stars

Stretch your theatre muscles with the creation of an original theatre show! With a focus on performance, you will hone skills through song, dance and speech exercises.

Origami Camping Trip

Enjoy the outdoors! Learn to fold paper tents, chairs, waterfalls and more to make your own origami campsites.

Origami Race Track

Let's get moving! You will learn how to make race cars, roads, flags and more using paper-folding techniques. Get creative by creating artistic scenes with origami.

Textile Creature Creations

Do you like cute, soft and loveable creatures? Learn how to make them all by yourself! Using skills, such as hand sewing, gluing and embroidery, you will craft your own unique treasures that you will be proud to share with family and friends.

Watercolours and Pastels

You'll be amazed at the results when you add a twist to traditional watercolour painting. Learn the basic techniques of watercolours and both soft and oil pastels, then explore combining the two mediums to create unique works of art.
