Half-day Intensives • Grades 6 – 9



Rainforest Adventure Classes

3D Origami Forest

There is nothing more fun than creating your own little paper world with your hands. You will learn to fold trees, monkeys and birds using origami techniques. Make your forest come to life with colourful origami papers. Teacher: Sarah Park

Contemporary Dance

Go on an adventure to the rainforest in this fun contemporary dance class. Dance moves will be inspired by playing in puddles, swinging in trees and monkeying around! Wear comfortable clothes you can move in; class will be taught barefoot. Teacher: Ashley Binette

Creative Clay: Forest Fun

Explore the magical environment of the rainforest through exciting clay projects. You will learn clay building techniques to bring your creations to life. Have fun making fuzzy and furry or slippery and slimy flora and fauna sculptures! Projects will be fired and available to pick up the week after the class. Teacher: Noelle Horrocks

Drawing and Painting Capybaras

Have fun mixing and blending colours and learn some new drawing tricks! Using pencils, crayons, markers and pastels, you'll create a drawing of a cute capybara in its rainforest habitat. Teacher: Olga Pirogova

Jungle Drums and Forest Soundscapes

Using drums and percussion instruments, recordings, synthesizers and computers, we will create soundscapes and rhythmic landscapes that evoke the mystery of the jungle or forest. This class is sure to inspire the musician in you! No experience necessary. Teacher: Jason Overy

Jungle Lizards

Design a colourful rainforest lizard! Using pastels and watercolor paints, you'll bring your lizard to life with colours and line. Teacher: Cara Bain

Learn Rhythm:

Voice, Piano and Percussion

Learn simple beats like you might hear in the rainforest as you read patterns and create rhythms with your voice, the piano and mini percussive instruments. Teacher: Kat Gillis

Musical Theatre

Explore the world of the rainforest through musical theatre! You'll learn basic singing, dancing and acting skills culminating in a group piece to a song inspired by the rainforest. Teacher: Megan Phillips

Rainforest Finger Puppets

Get inspired by rainforest animals and make your own paper puppet where your fingers become the animal's legs. Teacher: Dawn Livera

The Great Bear Rainforest

The Spirit Bear, found only in the Great Bear Rainforest of British Columbia, is a symbol of peace and harmony. Using naturally coloured sheep fleece you will learn about felting and create your own beautiful white Spirit Bear. Teacher: Catherine Dumaine
