About the Award

Every year, the Supportive Housing Network of New York honors **1-2 supportive housing tenants** who have demonstrated leadership, personal growth, and made a positive impact on their supportive housing and/or wider community.

Selected honorees will be required to participate in the following:

- Work with the Network and our videographer in the **filming and creation of a 2-3-minute celebratory video** about them video that is screened at the gala and promoted on Network website and social media
- **Attend the Network's in-person gala** on October 26th, 6-9pm at Capitale, 130 Bowery, New York, NY and briefly accept their award on-stage after their video is screened.

Selected honorees will receive:

- Free admission to the 2026 Awards alongside their nominator and/or case manager
- A \$250 gift certificate
- A physical award
- Recognition on the Network's website and social media in addition to at the gala
- Travel and lodging support for out-of-town honorees
- Free admission for both honoree and their nominator/case manager to the 2027 New York State Supportive Housing Conference

All nominees will be invited to a post-event breakfast celebration in early 2027 where they will receive a certificate of recognition.

Why nominate or encourage a tenant to apply?

This is a unique opportunity to:

- Shine a spotlight on a tenant's personal achievements.
- Celebrate transformative power of supportive housing.
- Inspire the broader community with their personal story and celebrate their impact.



Nomination Criteria:

- Nominees must:
 - **Be comfortable being filmed and featured in a 2–3-minute video**, including participation from trusted program staff, peers, or friends.
 - **Have lived in supportive housing for at least a year**, defined as: a permanent single-site residence or scattered site apartment program with on-site wrap-around services.
- Demonstrate how supportive housing has positively impacted their life.
- Have made a positive and inspirational mark, in ways that may include:
 - Demonstrated leadership within their building, local community, workplace, or school
 - Achieved personal milestones or growth since entering supportive housing
 - Showed resilience, creativity or initiative in the face of substantial challenges

Nomination instructions/requirements:

1. **Discuss opportunity/process with the tenant** and review past honorees to ensure interest:

2. **Confirm availability for:**
 - Filming a 2-3-minute video with peers and staff with Network videographer
 - Attending the gala on October 26th, 2026 from 6-9pm in NYC (no speech necessary)
3. **Submit the following to Ashanti Lee by Friday, August 21st to alee@shnny.org:**
 - **Completed Neighbor of the Year Nomination Application Form (Page 4)**
 - **A typed narrative** (maximum 500 words) written by the tenant, case manager, program director, or other trusted friend/partner, that:
 - Includes concrete examples of the individual's accomplishments, personal growth, leadership, community service or volunteer efforts
 - Explains the role supportive housing played in these accomplishments, along with descriptions/examples of reasons you'd like to celebrate the tenant
 - **Signed nomination consent form by tenant (Page 5)**
 - **One letter of reference** from a case manager, program director, or fellow tenant
 - A **photograph** of the tenant

Please note:

- Nominees must be supportive housing tenants
- Balance of state members are strongly encouraged to apply



- Previous nominees are welcome to re-apply.
- Due to space limitations, gala attendance is limited to selected honorees and their guests.
