Spotlight: Measles

In 2025, there have been over 700 cases of measles across the US. 11% of cases have been hospitalized and there have been 3 deaths from measles. If you suspect a patient has Measles: <u>Isolate</u>, <u>Test</u>, <u>Report</u>, <u>and Vaccinate</u>.

In the event of a measles exposure, healthcare providers should be prepared to vaccinate with MMR vaccine for Post Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP) as your local health department cannot vaccinate those who are insured.

• Spotlight: LTBI Medication Update Rifapentine (Priftin®) is back in stock at the Wisconsin TB Dispensary Pharmacy. New orders for rifapentine will be filled as supplies allow.

To help protect against interruptions of therapy due to future shortage, the Wisconsin TB Dispensary Pharmacy will hold the full 12-week supply of rifapentine at the time of the first fill. If new orders exceed supply, priority will be given to TB contacts and those with <a href="high-risk factors">high-risk factors</a>.

Note: pharmacies across the state may still be experiencing a shortage. If you are obtaining rifapentine from a local pharmacy, ensure the full 12-week supply is available before starting the medication to ensure no interruptions of treatment. Contact the Wisconsin TB Program with any questions.

Stable availability: Isoniazid (INH), Rifampin (4R)
