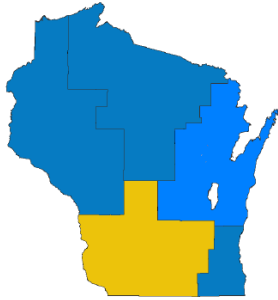

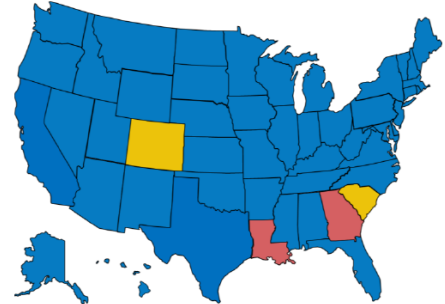

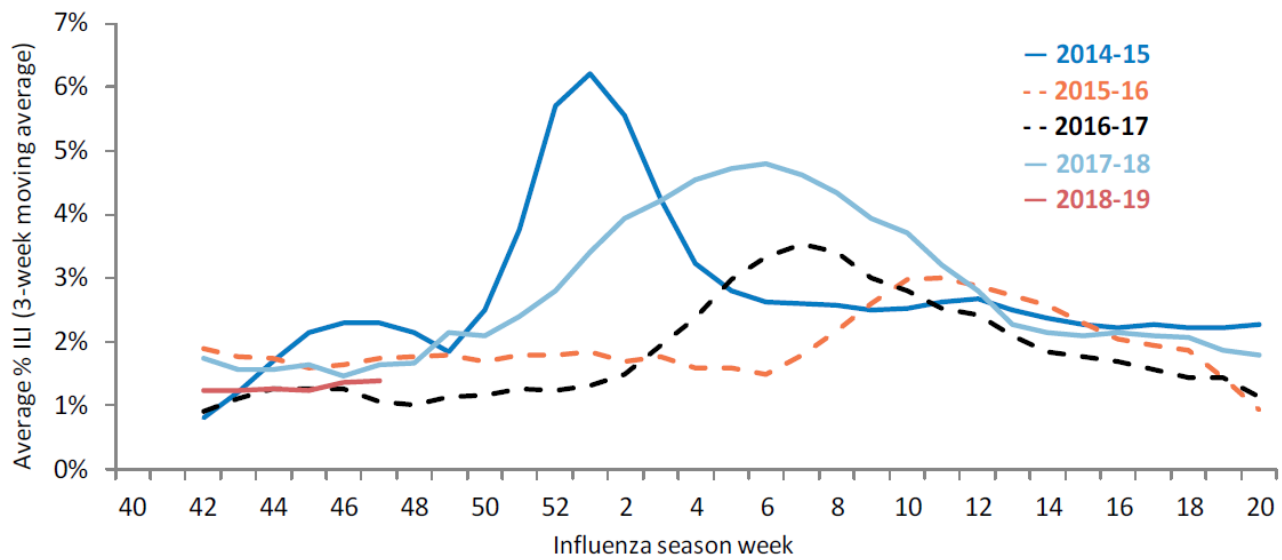
CURRENT ALERTS:
