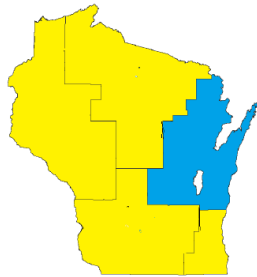

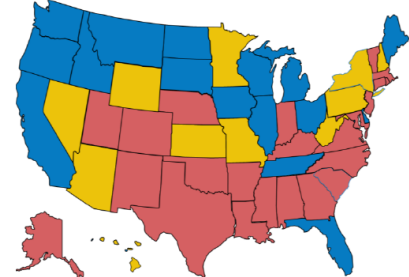

RSV continues to be the predominant virus this week.

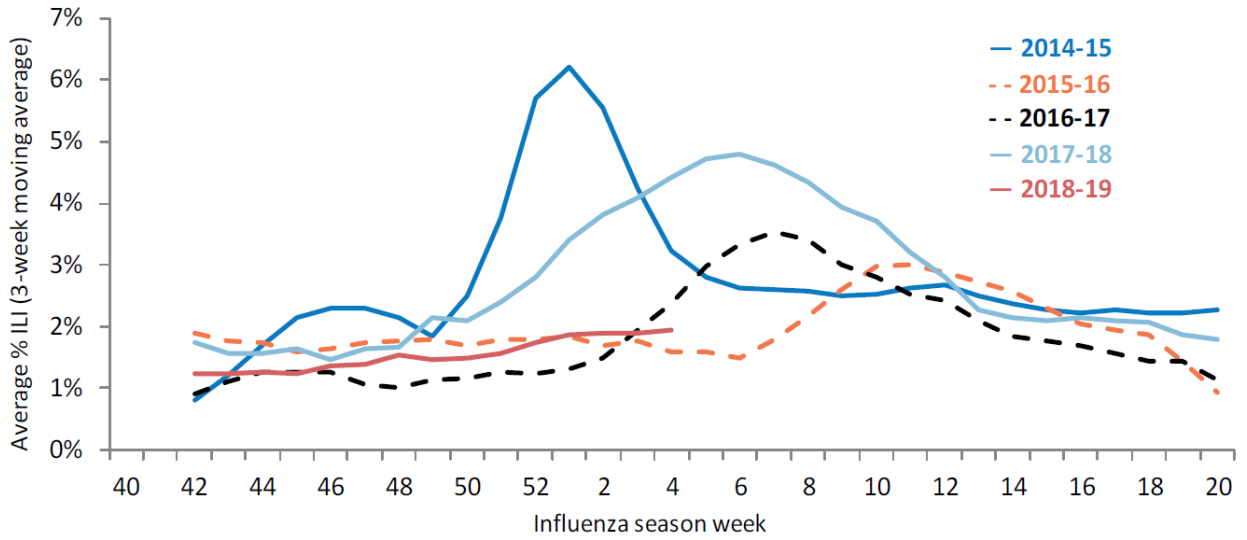
CURRENT ALERTS:
