




REGION V OF US (WI, MN, IL, MI, OH, IN)

CURRENT ALERTS:

Influenza B (Victoria lineage) continues to be the predominant influenza virus in Wisconsin.

A total of 15 flu related deaths have been reported in Wisconsin this season.

The first flu pediatric flu related death in Wisconsin was reported this week.
