

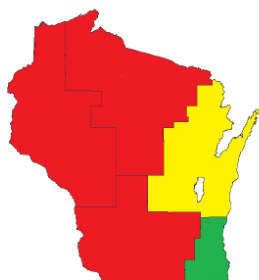

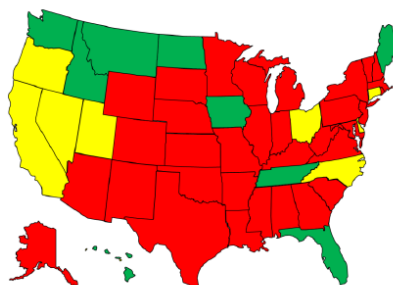

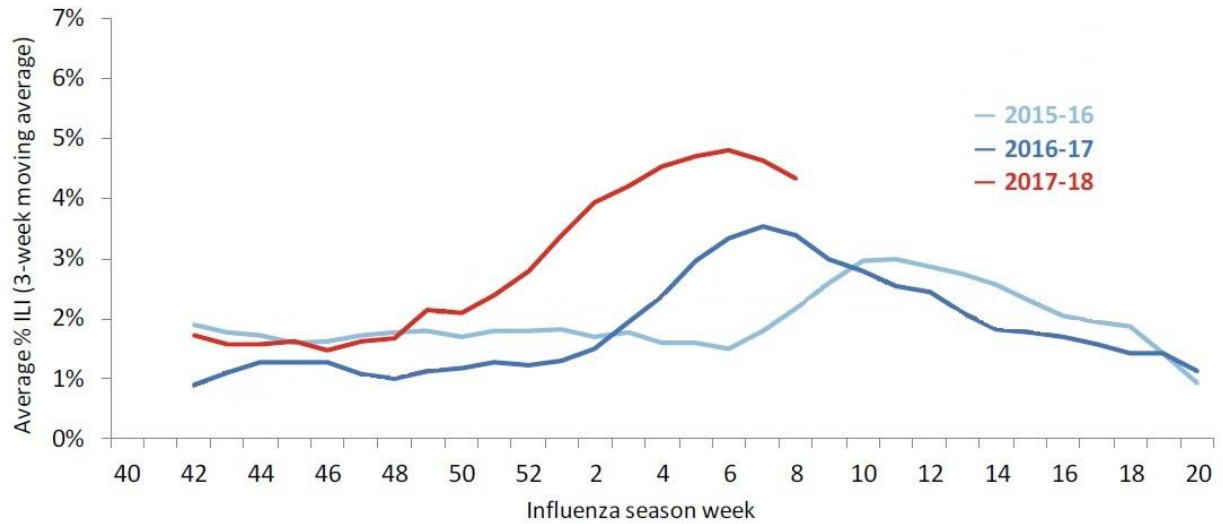
CURRENT ALERTS:

- Influenza activity has peaked, although high activity can be expected for several more weeks. Record number of hospitalizations, admissions to ICU and mechanical ventilation cases have occurred. Influenza B and A/H1N1 are becoming more common.
