<p>Incident Update:</p>  <p>Incident QR Code</p>	<p>The Bonny Fire displayed moderate fire activity overnight and continues to burn in extremely rugged and steep terrain. Today, the escalating temperatures pose additional challenges for firefighting efforts. Moreover, there is a chance of thunderstorms developing in the afternoon, heightening the risk of erratic fire behavior.</p> <p>Firefighters will continue constructing containment lines around the perimeter. Simultaneously, they are providing structure defense measures to safeguard the residents of Terwilliger Valley from the approaching fire.</p>
<p>Evacuation Orders:</p>	<p>Evacuation Order has been issued for residents of the Terwilliger Valley Community.
