CURRENT SITUATION

Incident Update:  Incident QR Code	The fire did not spread beyond the current footprint today, giving firefighters an opportunity to increase containment around the fire perimeter while continuing to cool hot spots. Winds were also favorable, as the east winds experienced in the fire area since Monday diminished through the morning. The steep and rugged terrain remains a challenge, and shifting wind patterns could cause flare-ups within the fire perimeter. Firefighters will continue working through the night to cool hot spots and address any issues related to the predicted wind shift.
