

8→9th Grade Registration Information

On the reverse side of this sheet is the Registration Planner to guide students in their course selection. Core courses choices are on the left-hand side of the page with elective options on the right. Just so you are aware, if students do not take a full year of music and world language (Option 1), they will have at least one semester of a study hall.

Following listening to the recorded sessions in Advisory Monday – Wednesday, February 22-24, counselors from the high school will be reviewing registration information with your student in their 8th grade Science Check and Connect class time on February 25 or 26 (depending on when they have Science). It is important to review this information, as your student will be completing their course registration directly in PowerSchool on those days.

Counselors will be able to help answer any questions during this day to help the student make the best course selections possible. If you are unsure about World Language or Math placement, please consult with your student's current teacher.

Students <u>must know their PowerSchool Log-in and Password</u> to ensure this process runs smoothly. If your student needs to double check their information, please have them talk to their advisory teacher or contact the Student Services Office.
