## St. Louis Park Public Schools students and families:

Instructional planning for the 2021-2022 school year is underway. The collection of school-issued Chromebooks, iPads, mobile hotspots and associated chargers prior to the last day of school is essential to ensure digital tools are available for learning at the start of next school year.

Beginning Monday, May 17 IN-PERSON
LEARNING STUDENTS can begin to bring
devices to school for collection. 'Collected'
means returned to their classroom teacher at
the elementary level, their Advisor at the Middle
School, or their Park Connections advisor at
the High School. Once returned devices will no
longer be checked out or used by the students
onsite and no additional tools will be checked out
to them. Access to digital tools will be available
to use onsite once devices have been collected.

will continue to use their school-issued device
