

# Get involved in Middle School Site Council or in a volunteer role in 2019/20!

## What is the Middle School Site Council?

- A group of parents and staff that serve the Middle School by advising the administration and supporting student enrichment through fundraising, volunteer recruitment, and event planning

## What is the Site Council Mission Statement?

- To serve the school community, advise the administration, and support student enrichment through fundraising, volunteer recruitment, event planning, and community engagement.

## What Site Council positions are open next year?

- Site council co-chair (typically filled by someone with previous experience on Site Council)
- Treasurer
- Various Site and grade level representation:
  - Goal is to get one or two 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade level reps from each elementary school site to be on Site Council and work with staff to advise the administration.

## When are Site Council meetings?

- Typically meets the 3rd Wednesday of each month; 3:45 – 5:15 (official times TBD)

## What Volunteer lead positions are open next year?

- Global intern Coordinator
- Coffee with the Principal Lead

## Can I volunteer or lead something as a volunteer without being on Site Council?

- Yes, any parent that can commit to attending 5+ of the 7-8 Site Council meetings each year can serve in the advisory capacity of Site Council.
- The Site Council co-chairs and SC leadership also work to ensure all volunteer needs are covered by recruiting volunteer leads for various things like Binder Buddies, Global Intern support, conference meals, field trip support, week 1 lunchroom support, etc.
