Energy Assistance can help

Too many people have to choose between paying their energy bill and other necessities – food, medicine, and healthcare. Minnesota's Energy Assistance Program helps households pay their energy bills so they do not have to choose between life's necessities.

The Energy Assistance Program:

- ♦ Serves both renters and homeowners
- ♦ Provides grants ranging from \$200 to \$1,400, with an average grant of about \$545
- ♦ Grant amounts are based on the household's heating costs, household size, and income
- ♦ Provides help with energy disconnections, no/low fuel in the tank, and homeowners' furnace repairs
- ♦ Eligibility is based on the household's past 3 months of income and assets are not counted

Eligibility examples:

<i>Household size</i>	<i>Past 3 months max. income</i>
1	\$ 6,495
2	\$ 8,494
3	\$10,493
4	\$12,492
