

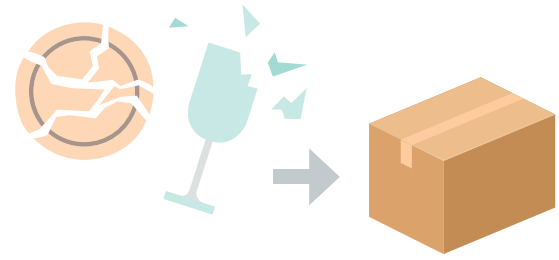
Black cart



What goes in:



Dryer lint, cotton swabs and dental floss



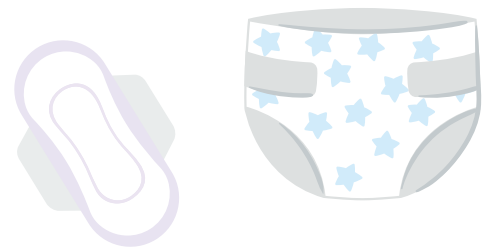
Broken, sharp objects (sealed in box)



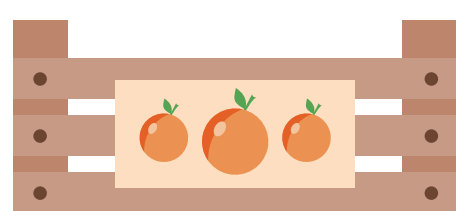
Compostable containers



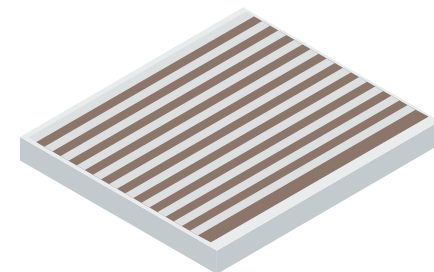
Flushables and disposable wipes



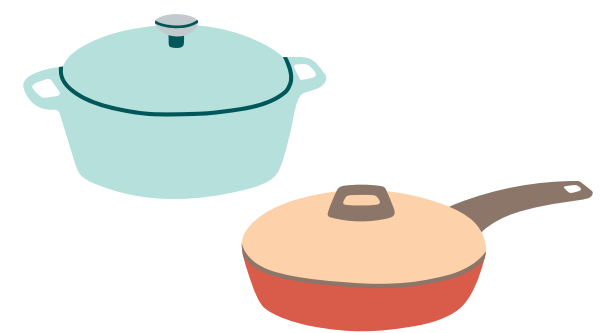
Diapers, and hygiene products



Wooden orange crates



Filters



Pots and pans

Tips and tricks:

- Broken glass must be placed in a cardboard box no larger than 12 x 12 x 12 inches (30 x 30 x 30 centimetres) and no more than 20 pounds (9 kilograms), securely taped shut and labelled as “BROKEN GLASS”, then place inside your black garbage cart
- Save space in your cart by using the organics and recycling
- Make sure the lid is closed with no items on top
- Bags are not required

What stays out:

- Organics
- Recycling
- Banned items (corrugated cardboard, electronic waste, tires, etc.)
- Hazardous waste (cleaners, batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, etc.)
- No automotive parts, dead animals, liquids or needles/syringes
