Bring to Every Class

Please bring your **sketchbook and drawing pencils to each class.**

Required Supplies

- **Sketchbook** — Any size is fine
- **Drawing pencils** — HB, B, 2B, 4B, and 6B
You may have additional pencils, but please have at least these grades.
- **Vine and/or willow charcoal** — Soft charcoal is recommended. A variety of charcoal stick sizes can be useful.
- **Compressed charcoal sticks** — White and black
- **White drawing paper pad** — 18" × 24" recommended; slightly smaller is fine
- **Grey toned paper** — At least 2 sheets
- **Kneaded eraser** — 1
- **White eraser** — 1
- **X-Acto knife** — For sharpening pencils and shaping charcoal
- **Artist chamois**
- **Workable spray fixative**

Optional Supplies

- **Drawing board** — Drawing boards are available in the classroom, but you are welcome to bring your own
- **Charcoal pencils**

Where to Purchase Supplies

You are welcome to purchase supplies wherever you prefer. Any product links provided are simply examples—you **do not need to purchase the specific brand or shop from the linked retailer.**

Local options include:

- **Lynn's of Madison** — West side of Madison and highly recommended by your instructor
- **Artist & Craftsman Supply** — Downtown, just off State Street
- **The Art Hatchery** — Stoughton; a secondhand art supply store that can be a less expensive and more sustainable option, although availability varies

For online shopping, **Blick Art Materials** is a good option with reasonable prices. Their selection can be a little overwhelming if you're not sure what you're looking for, so the example links in this list can help guide you.
