Saturday, March 12, 10am - 1pm

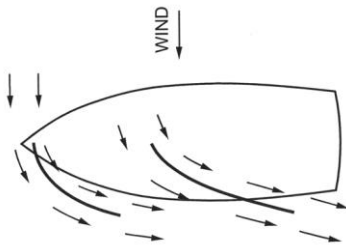
You want to take the leap into the world of chartering but don't know where to begin? This clinic is geared toward answering questions and giving a few tips on planning your
