The Conference Program Committee is pleased to offer up to 10 Young Investigator Travel Awards of up to \$1,000 each to eligible conference attendees who present a poster at the NNDC 2024 Annual Conference. This award can be used to request reimbursement for travel costs associated with attending the conference, including airfare, hotel, ground transportation, parking, and mileage, as appropriate. Awards do not cover conference registration fees.

Who is eligible to apply for a Young Investigator Travel Award?

To be eligible to apply for a Young Investigator Travel Award, you must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Be the author or co-author on the poster that you are presenting at the Annual Conference.
2. Be a graduate student, fellow, post-doctoral fellow, resident, or junior faculty within 5 years of fellowship or post-graduate appointment at one of the 26 NNDC Member Sites.

Applicants from under-represented minority groups are particularly encouraged to apply for a Young Investigator Travel Award.

How do I apply?

To apply for a Travel Award, you must submit a letter of recommendation from your program director, faculty advisor, or NNDC Board Member representing your site in addition to your abstract. Letters can be sent to nndc@nndc.org, with the subject line "**Young Investigator Travel Award Application.**"

Complete applications (including poster abstract) must be submitted for consideration by **5:00 pm EST on July 31, 2024.**
