Timothy P. O'Malley, Ph.D. is director of education at the McGrath Institute for Church Life, University of Notre Dame. He also serves as the academic director of the Notre Dame Center for Liturgy. Dr. O'Malley has a concurrent appointment in the Department of Theology at the University of Notre Dame where he teaches in liturgical-sacramental theology, catechesis, and marriage-family.

He is the author of seven books most recently *Invitation and Encounter: Evangelizing through the*



Sacraments (Our Sunday Visitor, 2022), *Becoming Eucharistic People: The Hope and Promise of Parish Life* (Ave Maria Press, 2022), and *Real Presence: What Does It Mean and Why Does It Matter?* (Ave Maria Press, 2021).

In addition, Dr. O'Malley serves the Church on the Executive Committee of the National Eucharistic Revival, where he coordinates work related to liturgy and devotions and outreach to college campuses.

He is a theological consultant for the Laity, Marriage, Family Life, and Youth committee of the USCCB. Dr. O'Malley is also a member of the University of Incarnate Word's board of trustees' mission committee.

He is married to Kara and has two children, ages 9 and 5.
