

Dr. Brad Edgren was honored as a guest lecturer at the Rocky Mountain Orthodontics® Diagnostic and Early Treatment Seminar. The two-day lecture, presented to Orthodontists, Dentists and Pediatric Dentists from the US and abroad, focused on the importance of treating the growing dentofacial skeleton rather than the narrower objective of treating just the teeth and/or just the occlusion and realizing the consequences of delaying early interceptive treatment.

Dr. Brad Edgren is a Board-Certified Orthodontist and a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics. He is a well-known author on clinical orthodontics. He lectures nationally and internationally on a variety of orthodontic topics covering early interceptive orthodontic treatment, cephalometric analysis, growth and development, upper airway obstruction, and cone beam computed tomography. In addition, Dr. Edgren is an advisory editor of Orthodontic Practice Journal U.S., member of the prestigious Edward H. Angle Society of Orthodontists, and a Fellow of the American College of Dentists and the International College of Dentists. He earned his Orthodontic Certificate and Master of Science in Orthodontics on Temporo-Mandibular Joint Disorders and Orthognathic Surgery from the same institution.
