### **Subject: Sewer Line Project Closes 2nd Street and Sections of 14th Avenue**

Construction work to improve sewer flows in northeast Greeley will completely close one road and partially close another near Island Grove Regional Park starting Jan. 16 for about ten days.

The City of Greeley Water and Sewer Department has scheduled a project for construction Jan. 16 through 26 with closures on 14th Avenue and 2nd Street. Read more about each closure below. Local access to residences and businesses will be available for the duration of the project.

#### **14th Avenue Closure**

Southbound 14th Avenue from A Street through 2nd Street will close for the duration of the project. The northbound lane of 14th Avenue will remain open but may experience some delays. During the closure, detour signs will direct southbound 14th Avenue traffic along A Street and 11th Avenue.

#### **2nd Street Closure**

2nd Street will close at the 14th Avenue intersection and slightly to the west for the duration of the project. Detour signs on 2nd Street at the 23rd Avenue intersection will direct drivers to a detour along 5th Street. Detour signs will reroute traffic going west on 2nd Street along 14th Avenue and 5th Street.

This project will perform needed maintenance and rehabilitation for Greeley's sanitary sewer infrastructure. These closures are necessary to ensure the safety of drivers and workers performing the repairs.
