



Thank you for volunteering with Senior Access. Our program couldn't operate without caring individuals like you!

Coming of Age is a partner of Senior Access and they provide our volunteers with free membership benefits that include limited mileage reimbursement (for volunteers over the age of 55), supplemental auto, accident and liability insurance, free training programs and more! Joining Coming of Age is quick and easy; just complete a membership form. If you would like to receive mileage reimbursement, you also need to complete a W9 (only used to establish you as a vendor* because you cannot exceed \$400 per year reimbursement this income is not reported to the IRS) and provide your current odometer reading. You can also choose to complete a form to have your reimbursement directly deposited into your account. Volunteers who are able are asked to donate your reimbursement check back to Senior Access (do not complete the optional direct deposit form if you plan to donate). You can receive up to \$25 if you drive 125 miles or more per month. Your generosity could result in an extra \$300 a year to benefit our clients!
