- Responsibility to ensure that any borrowed publications are of the latest amendment status, and ensure that they concur with the manufacture's publications status list prior to use;
- Creating planned maintenance job cards utilizing the computerized maintenance tracking program;
- Ensuring the yearly audit is completed in compliance with regulations stated in CAR 706.03(6) utilizing Transport Canada Audit and Inspection Manual as the basis for the audit;
- Maintaining computer maintenance tracking Remote Access Aviation System (RAAS) data base;
- Plan and implement changes, updates and enhancements required to manage aviation associated technical records, stores, for Air Tindi Ltd.
- Follow the SMS manual and participate in and encourage safety in the workplace;
- Other duties as required.

- Minimum of 5+ years of experience on fixed wing;
