He received the Health Equity Leadership award from the Baltimore City Health Department and is coauthor of the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) Handbook of Addiction Medicine.



Susan Lehmann, MD is the inaugural Patricia B. and William T. Bright Professor of Mental Wellness and the Clinical Director of Geriatric Psychiatry and Neuropsychiatry at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. She is a recipient of a number of national awards including the American Association for Geriatric Psychiatry Educator of the Year. She is coeditor of the recently published book, *Bipolar Disorder in Older Age Patients*.
