

WHO WE ARE

- Co-founded by a physical therapist and a technology engineer, both UConn graduates
- Registered in Conn., February 2019
 - 501(c)(3) non-profit, April 2019
 - Web platform launch, June 2019
- 100% volunteer-based; all grants and donations cover direct program costs (\$100 per participant annually)
- Protected end-to-end
 - Fully insured (in 50 states)
 - Background checks of all participants
 - Secure website and email

ROADMAP for COMMUNITY MEMBERS

Age 70 and older or 18 and older with a temporary or permanent physical disability

- ENROLL and complete our background check -- online or by phone
- INITIATE the requests for help with housework, yard work or companionship visits including errands and local transportation
- Pre-scheduling allows for caregiver respite opportunities
- All services are provided at no charge; donations welcome

Be a Partner - Receive authorization to efficiently enroll and schedule Community Deeds for multiple Community Members or Volunteers.

Who: Our Partner Organizations (PO) are set up to enroll multiple residents, in two categories.

- **Volunteer PO (VPO)**: Police, fire, library, high schools, colleges, nonprofits, faith organizations can sign up groups of volunteers to volunteer together.
- Community Member PO (CMPO): Human services, senior center, hospitals, insurance companies, housing authority and other agencies can enroll people and manage their accounts to ensure inclusion and equity for those without access to technology (email, internet).

What: The PO enrolls and schedules community deeds for Community Members (CM) and informs CM's to know when a Volunteer (Vol) is coming to their house. A contact person or designated staff member of the PO manages the account.

Why: The CMPO is in contact with those CMs weekly/monthly/as needed and can schedule Deeds on their behalf. The VPO gets email notifications of the CM requests and accepts the scheduled deeds based on VPO availability. The PO allows towns to coordinate services to maximize existing resources.

When: The CMPO uses URCommunityCares.org to schedule and report on the deeds. The VPO views deeds and accepts those that fit with their schedule, and types in a testimonial/rating afterwards.

Where: URCommunityCares.org is an online platform, mobile friendly to connect participants within your town and surrounding 15-mile radius.

How: The CMPO will set the schedule and VPO accepts deeds accordingly.

URCommunityCares.org meets website accessibility standards and is currently available in six languages:

English, Arabic, Chinese (simplified), Hindi, Spanish and Portuguese.

My volunteer is kind and compassionate. We both are self-isolating due to underlying health issues, so we decided to do our Community Deeds by phone. It's perfect for playing word games, discussing current affairs and exploring how to use technology together. We meet mostly once a week at the same time and I think we both look forward to it.
