Skills Training (ASIST) is a
two-day workshop designed
for family, friends, community
members and those in formal
helping roles who may be the
first to talk with a person
having thoughts of suicide.

ASIST teaches the skills needed to provide suicide first aid help as part of the care you provide.

Participants learn how to:

- Recognize people at risk of suicide
- Talk, hear their story and understand their situation
- Help them stay safe with a life-affirming intervention
